- One (1) Forces Member Trustee representing South African National Defence Force (SANDF) and State Security Agency (SSA)

#### Independent Electoral Officer

GEPF has appointed KDBS Consulting (Pty) Ltd as the Independent Electoral Officer (IEO) to manage and conduct this election. The IEO will ensure that the election process is conducted with transparency, integrity, and in accordance with the GEPF Election Policy and applicable legislation.

From 18 February 2026, the certified Voters' Roll will be published on the election website for inspection. Members are strongly encouraged to verify that their details are accurate and current. If your contact details (email address and/or mobile number) are missing or incorrect, you must update your records on the GEPF App as a valid email address or cell number is mandatory for participation in the election process.

GEPF App is downloadable on all App stores.

We encourage all eligible members to actively participate in this election by inspecting the Voters' Roll, update your records, if necessary, consider nomination as a candidate, and exercise your vote when the voting period opens. Your participation strengthens the democratic governance of the Fund and ensures that member interests are represented at the highest level.
